ALGAECIDE SET – against black algae

Various types of algae can grow on the surface of the pool or in the water itself, under strong sunlight and inadequate levels of disinfectant. The most stubborn of these is the black algae, which adheres strongly to both the fugue and the pelvic lining, forming a multilayer colony, thus protecting the inner algae layers.

However, the **ALGAECIDE SET** developed **AGAINST BLACK ALGAE** provides an effective solution to curb black algae proliferation and facilitate removal.

TREATMENT STEPS:

BRUSH YOUR POOL

Scrub down all the surfaces of your swimming pool well, including steps, corners, pool wall, and under ladders to loose the top layer of the colonies.

- ADD DINAX PHOSPHATE MINUS EXTRA TO THE WATER
 Under working water rotation, add 750 ml of DINAX PHOSPHATE MINUS EXTRA liquid to the pool water per 10 m³. In this quantity, the product significantly reduces the phosphate level of the water, thereby depriving the algae from nutrients.
- 3. ADD 400 ml of ALGI-CID (anti-algae fluid) per 10 ml water.

4. TURN ON THE PUMP

Rotate the water for another 24 hours, then scrub the surface again with a brush.

5. SHOCK YOUR POOL

After 2 hours of rotation, wash the sand filter thoroughly and then shock with **DINAX FILTER KONDI WP** according to its instructions for use.

6. TEST THE WATER CHEMISTRY

Next, ensure the level of disinfectant, check it daily, and if necessary add additional disinfectant.

7. WEEKLY DOSING

On day 7 of treatment and then once a week, add 150 ml of **DINAX PHOSPHATE MINUS EXTRA** and 100 ml of **ALGI-CID** per 10 m³ to pool water.
